Cost of Memorial is \$600.00

The Forestry staff will determine the final location where the memorial tree is needed and the type of tree that will be planted. Memorial granite markers at ground level are the only item allowed near the donated tree. Ribbons, stuffed animals, flowers, etc. are not permitted. Purchase and installation of the memorial marker will be handled by the City. The granite marker will be left in place until such a time as it is no longer readable/ functional.
