<u>**Definition:**</u> Under general supervision, enforces city, state and federal laws and regulations by responding to calls for assistance.

<u>Essential Functions:</u> (Essential functions, as defined under the Americans with Disabilities Act, may include the following tasks, knowledge, skills and other characteristics. This list is ILLUSTRATIVE ONLY and is not a comprehensive listing of all functions and tasks performed by positions in this class).

Tasks:

- Patrols city to prevent or deter crime; arrests violators; interprets and applies laws, regulations, policies and procedures. Enforces city, state, and federal laws and regulations.
- Investigates complaints
- Apprehends suspects; searches, inspects, transports and takes custody of prisoners.
- Interviews suspects and witnesses; secures crime scene, collects evidence and facts.
- Performs investigation of crimes and accidents; performs follow up duties on crimes and accidents as directed.
- Performs appropriate documentation of shift activity including logs, reports and forms
- Responds to calls for assistance, controls traffic at accident scenes, testifies in court as witness and/or reporting officer to a crime.

Knowledge, Skills and Other Characteristics:

- Knowledge of law enforcement practices and procedures.
- Knowledge of proper firearm handling techniques.
- Knowledge of city, state, and federal laws and regulations.
- Skill in analytical, objective observances of situations and quick decision making.
- Skill in managing situations firmly, courteously, tactfully and impartially.
- Skill in recording information accurately and completely.
- Skill in establishing cooperative work relationships with those contacted in the course of work.

Qualifications:

High School diploma and ability to pass state certification as police officer.
