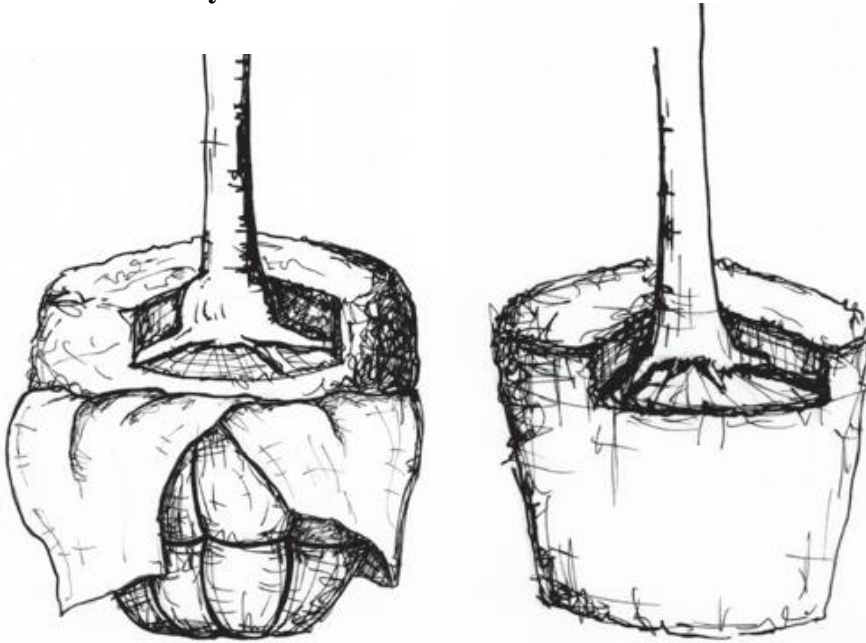


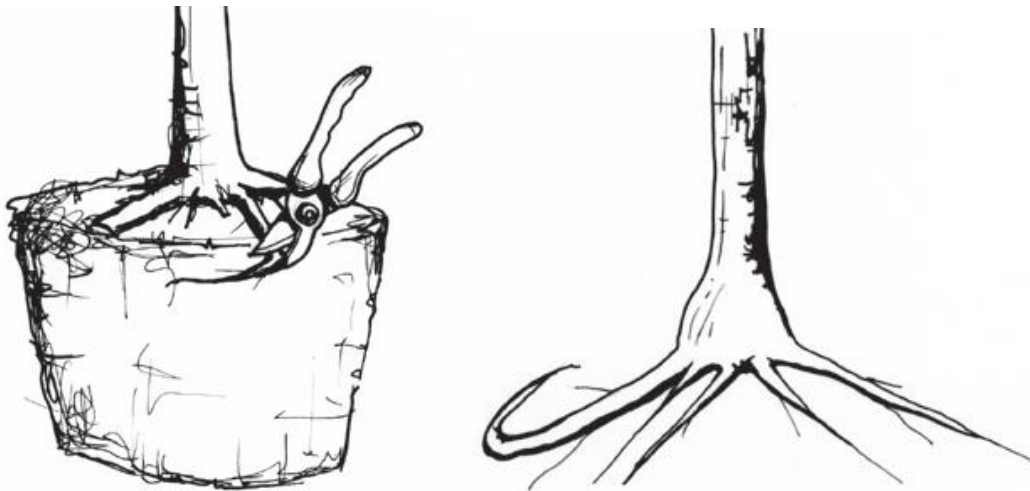
Planting Guide

Planting

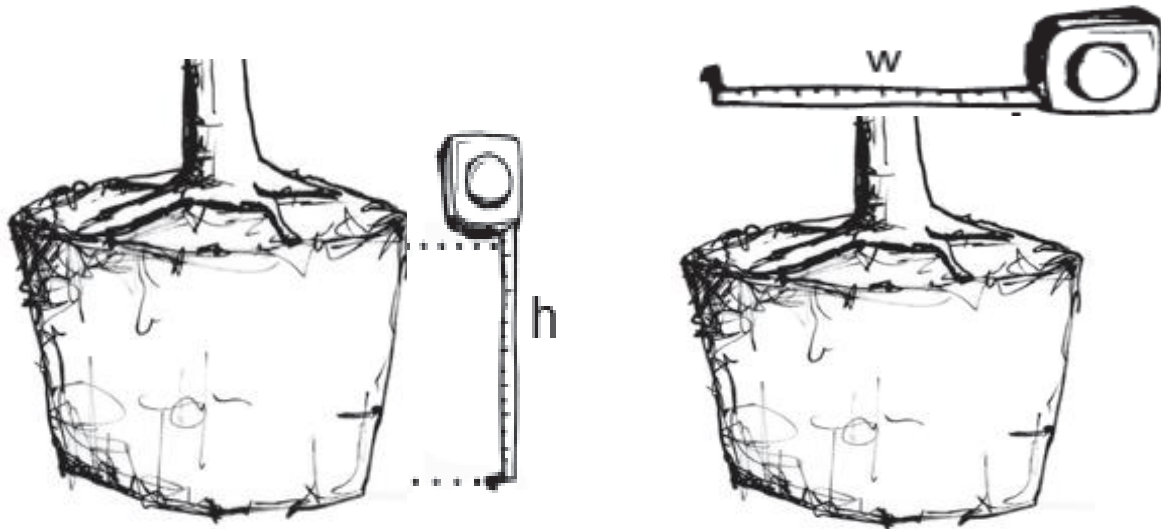
When planting from nursery container or balled and burlapped, start by removing excess soil from root ball until top of root system is found, you may need to remove 2-4 inches of soil to find root system at times.



Remove problem roots above the main root system with a hand pruner. Examine the main root system for roots that extend out but then turn to side or back towards the trunk. Prune these roots at the point where they turn.



Determine how deep and how wide to dig. Measure the height of remaining root ball. This is how deep you should dig the hole. Measure the width of the root ball or root system. Multiply this by 2 or in clay soils by 3. This is how wide you should dig.
