WHAT IS SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING?

Single stream recycling is a system in which all recyclables, including newspaper, magazines, cardboard, plastic, aluminum and tin cans, and glass jars and bottles are comingled in a single, red, 95 gallon single stream recycling roll cart.

THINKING GREEN

In efforts to make the City as clean -and green- as possible, starting in Spring 2017, every resident on city solid waste collection and participating businesses will receive a red, plastic roll cart for their recyclables.

These carts are city property and need to remain with the residence.

need to go in regular
household garbage.
