




Dive In, Yankton!

O Lewis and Clark Lake attracts nearly 2 million visitors annually, which is a tremendous opportunity for Yankton to attract a portion of those visitors into town.

O Yankton has 500+ available jobs, and quality of life amenities like a new aquatic center will help to attract families to Yankton to fill those jobs.





#### How will we fund this?

- The proposed facility will cost between \$14.5 and \$14.8 million.
- The City of Yankton will contribute \$2 million out of the existing budget.
- DIY is currently fundraising to lessen the burden on tax payers.
