<p>The following question is brought before the voters of the City of Yankton, South Dakota, for acceptance or rejection:</p> <p>Whether the City of Yankton should opt out of the tax limitation measure currently in statute up to \$884,043.00 annually starting with calendar year 2019 taxes payable in the calendar year 2020. This opt out will be for no more than twenty (20) years, which will be thru taxes payable in the calendar year 2039.</p> <p><b>CITY ATTORNEY'S EXPLANATION:</b> On October 8, 2018, the Yankton City Commission adopted Resolution #18-67, the purpose of which was to opt out of the tax limitation measure currently in statute of up to, but not exceeding \$884,043.00 annually for no more than twenty (20) years starting with calendar year 2019 taxes payable in the calendar year 2020. The City of Yankton would be authorized, but not required to levy and collect the full amount. The increased tax revenue can be used only for debt service (loan payments) for the proposed construction of a new aquatics facility to replace the existing 70 year-old pool in Fantle-Memorial Park.</p> <p>A vote "Yes" is a vote to approve the opt out of the current tax limitation as set forth above to provide additional tax revenue necessary for the City of Yankton to proceed with the new aquatics facility.</p> <p>A vote "No" is a vote against the opt out of the current tax limitation as set forth above, which is also a vote against authorizing additional tax revenue necessary to proceed with the new aquatics facility.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> <b>Yes</b> The City of Yankton may increase the tax levy by the amount of the opt-out.</p> <p><input type="radio"/> <b>No</b> Leave the tax levy as it is without the amount of the opt-out.</p>
